Pursuant to §17-12-9, District Committees must meet in January 2019 and within **ten (10) days** of the organizational meeting, file a list of its elected officers and members with the RI Department of State's Elections Division and with the local boards of canvassers in the cities/towns within the district.

Pursuant to §17-12-12, in the event of a vacancy, District Committees can fill vacancies:

- When the number of elected members does not equal the number entitled to the District;
- When a member dies, resigns, becomes incapacitated, moves out of the District or ceases to be a member of the political party.

### How to fill a District Committee vacancy:

- Any vacancy occurring in any of the officers and/or membership of the district committee shall be filled by the remaining members of the committee. A statement of that action, resignation and appointment, shall be filed with the Elections Division and with the local board(s) of canvassers.
- In the event a District Committee fails to organize pursuant to §17-12-9, the incumbent senator or representative (if of the same party) or the state committee chairperson (if of a different party), shall appoint a district committee.
