- 4. Box D (Voter's oath and signature) You must read the oath of voter and sign your name in full attesting to the oath. Your signature does not need to be witnessed or notarized.

- 7. Track your mail ballot Visit vote.ri.gov to sign up for Ballottrax. You will receive notifications on the status of your mail ballot application and mail ballot delivery information. Mail ballots are sent to voters approximately 3 4 weeks before the election. Election mail cannot be forwarded. Be sure to carefully check the address where you want your mail ballot sent.
- 8. Receiving your mail ballot Your mail ballot packet will have your ballot, instructions, voter's certificate and the required postage-paid envelope to return your voted ballot to the State Board of Elections.
