Pursuant to Chapter 17-12-9, district committees must meet and organize in January 2023 and within ten (10) days of the organizational meeting, file a list of its elected officers and members with the Department of State's Elections Division and with the local boards of canvassers in the cities/towns within the district. File original form at RI Department of State | 148 W. River Street | Providence

Pursuant to Chapter 17-12-12, a district committee vacancy exists:

- When the number of elected members does not equal the number entitled to the district;
- When a member resigns, dies, becomes incapacitated, moves out of the district or ceases to be a member of the political party.

How to fill a district committee vacancy:

- Any vacancy occurring in any of the officers and/or membership of the district committee shall be filled by the remaining members of the committee within forty-five (45) days of notice of the vacancy. A statement of that action, resignation, and appointment, shall be filed with the Department of State's Elections Division and the local board(s) of canvassers.
- If the vacancy is not filled within forty-five (45) days of the date of notice of the vacancy to the remaining members of the committee, the vacancy shall be filled by the state committee of the political party involved, the executive committee of the state committee or any duly elected subcommittee of the executive committee or by the state chairperson of the political party if so authorized. A statement of that action shall be filed with the Department of State's Elections Division and with the local board(s) of canvassers.
- In the event a district committee fails to organize pursuant to Chapter 17-12-9, the incumbent senator or representative (if of the same party) or the state committee chairperson (if of a different party), shall appoint a district committee.

Representative District Committees:

- Representative district committees have 3 members if the district is all in one city/town and has 5 members if the district encompasses more than one city/town.

Senate District Committees:

- Senate district committees have 5 members if the district is all in one city/town and has 7 members if the district encompasses more than one city/town.

A motion was made by Diane Allen seconded by Paul and passed unanimously to appoint Elaine Morgan as Chair of the Senate District Committee #34.


A motion was made by Elaine seconded by Paul and passed unanimously to appoint Diane Allen as Vice Chair of the District 34 Senate Committee.
